IF A RELATIONSHIP IS UNHEALTHY  
OR ABUSIVE.

Domestic violence can happen to anyone, regardless of age, race, class, religion, gender, or sexual orientation. Abusive behavior can appear at any time in the relationship, whether you are dating, married, or if you have children together. How can you tell if your relationship is abusive?

DOES YOUR PARTNER EVER...

- Criticize you down, embarrassed or make you feel bad about yourself?
- Control what you do, what you wear, who you see, talk to or where you go?
- Keep you from seeing your friends or family?
- Push, punch, slap, or strangle you?
- Tell you what you're a bad parent or threaten to take the children away?
- Force you to perform sexual acts when you don't want to?

If you answered "yes" to even one of these questions, you may be in an unhealthy or abusive relationship. No matter what the situation, abuse is not your fault, it's the person who is being hurtful or violent who chooses to behave this way.
